



Les Bourgs Hospice What's on Newsletter Spring 2016


We are always looking for ways to spread the word on what is happening here at the Hospice, so I am going to try to do a brief Newsletter each quarter to let you know.

Upcoming Events:



Make it in March – this is an event for those who are artistic, crafty or photographically minded!
